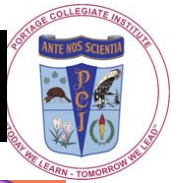

Basketball Fundraising



PCI is in dire need of an outdoor community basketball court. The current court is in bad shape leading to injury. Our student focus is on their health and mental fitness, encouraging them to be themselves, have fun with friends and be a part of both the community of PCI, and the community of Portage la Prairie.



On any given day, the court has students on it and in the evenings you either see that the youth have gone back or that there are members of the community shooting hoops.



It is a place for students to go on lunch hours and spares. Teenagers treat basketball as a universal activity, with no worries about skill level. It is a great opportunity for them to burn energy while also feeling safe hanging out with their friends.

The court area was formerly a tennis court and has a grass/dirt strip down the middle preventing players from playing a full-court game. The size of the space we have is 100 x 110 feet which will provide us with two full size courts with a space in between them and a buffer behind the nets for safety.



As PCI's Parent Advisory Council, we believe in not only the growth of our community and its members, but their mental and physical health, and are asking if you would be willing to work with us to provide a donation to make our outdoor courts safe for years to come.

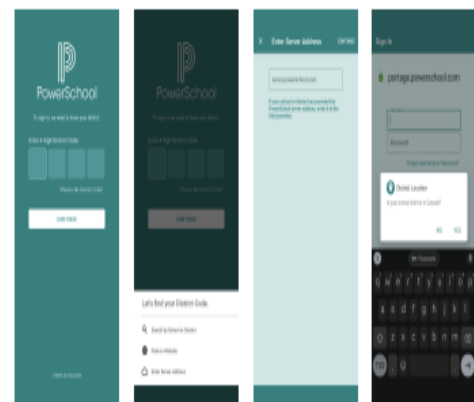
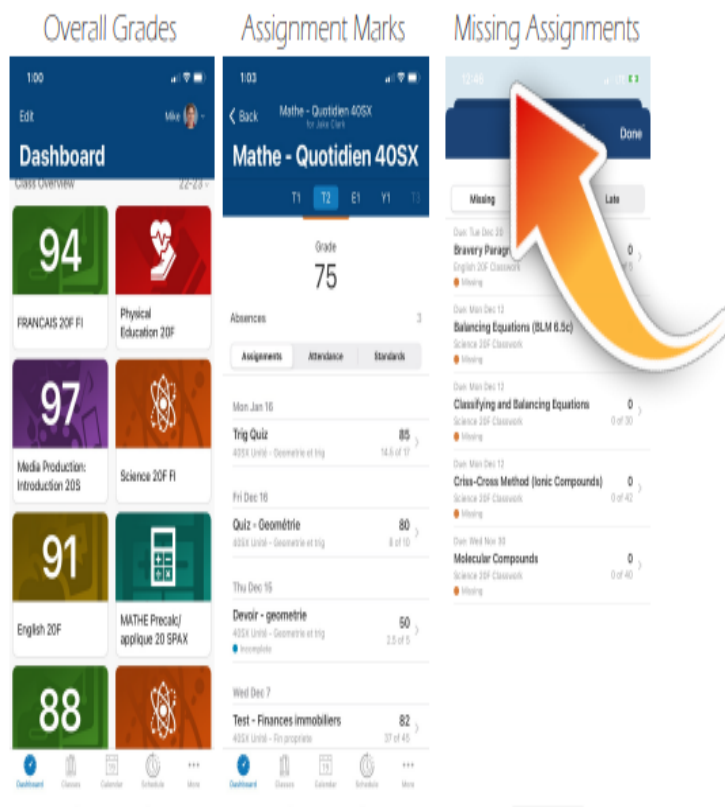

- Your Parent Portal account has already been set up for you.
 - You will need to create a password, though. To do this, open a web browser and navigate to portage.powerschool.com.
- **Do not include www in front of the address**
- Click on **forgot username or password**.
- You will now need to **enter your email address** in **both** the username and email address boxes.
 - Use the email address where you receive school emails
- Click the enter button.
- The system will email you a password reset link. It may take several minutes for you to receive the email.
 - Check your spam or junk folders if you've not received the email within 15 minutes.
 - The email link is only valid for 24 hours, so be sure to click the link and create your password within that time.
 - If the link expires, you can follow the same process again.

Once you've set up your account:



- **Download** the PowerSchool Mobile App.
- When you are prompted to add your district code
 - Click on "Where's my district code"
 - Choose "Enter Server Address" and then enter portage.powerschool.com
- Enter your email in "Username" and your new password.

InformNet - Manitoba's Online High School - offers full-credit online courses for students within the school year and an **online summer session from July 3 - 28, 2023**, inclusive.

The online repeater summer session courses are open to all students in Manitoba who have not successfully completed a course(s) during the regular academic year or wish to improve their passing grade. There is a limited selection of non-repeater online summer session courses too.

THE DETAILS

InformNet Summer Session is Manitoba's only online summer session program.

- Summer session online registration opens **May 2, 2023**, at <https://www.informnet.mb.ca/summer.html>
- Summer Session registration closes on July 5, 2023, or when capacity is reached.
- All online courses have a teacher who is available to the students on the weekdays.
- Students need access to a computer and the internet.
- Course materials are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week from July 3, 2023, to July 28, 2023, inclusive.
- All InformNet summer session courses close at 11:59 p.m. on July 28, 2023.

FEES

- Repeater-based courses are **\$285 per course**.
- Non-repeater-based courses are **\$570 per course**.

Due to time restrictions and the heavy workload associated with this level of course commitment, students are advised not to register for more than four repeater-based classes or two non-repeater-based classes.

*** Students who choose **non-repeater-based courses** should plan to allocate up to **four hours per day**, per course. "

*** Students who choose **repeater-based courses** (students need to have previously taken and completed the course and want to improve their mark) need to allocate **two hours a day**, per course. "

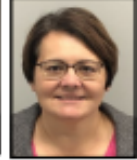

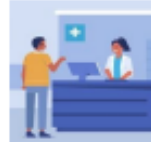
